June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart. Did you know, the most significant source for the devotion to the Sacred Heart in the form it is known today was Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690), a nun of the Order of the Visitation of Holy Mary, who received apparitions of Jesus Christ in the Burgundian French village of Paray-le-Monial, the first on 12/27/1673, the feast of Saint John the Evangelist, and the final one 18 months later, revealing the form of the devotion, the chief features being reception of Holy Communion on the First Friday of each month, Eucharistic adoration during a "Holy hour" on Thursdays, and the celebration of the Feast of the Sacred Heart. This is a great topic to discuss when "Passing on the Faith" to our grandchildren. Come to our meeting to learn more.
