

## *3RD STOP: VATICAN MUSEUMS AND THE SISTINE CHAPEL*

The Vatican Museums are the public museums of Vatican City. They display works from the immense collection amassed by the Catholic Church and the papacy throughout the centuries, including several of the most well-known Roman sculptures and most important masterpieces of Renaissance art in the world.

The Sistine Chapel is located inside the Vatican Museums and every year is visited by millions of tourists from all over the world. The Sistine Chapel is decorated with splendid <u>frescoes by Michelange-</u> <u>lo</u>. His wonderful works cover the <u>ceiling</u> and the back wall (with <u>the Last Judgement</u>) above the altar. The conclave, baptisms and other official ceremonies of the Pope are held inside the chapel.
