

COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND: The priest & Deacons perform this service monthly. Notify us when someone wishes to be visited.

DISCIPLE MAKER INDEX

During this past Lenten Season, the faithful across the Diocese of Allentown participated in the Disciple Maker Index, a survey of the faithful's assessment of their parish. The results of the survey will be announced on the weekend of September 14-15. This will mark the beginning of the next phase of the process, which will include the setting of parish goals and the establishment of a steering committee to assist and advise the pastors with the implementation of new initiatives and the attainment of the parish goals. A committee will be formed at St. John the Baptist and Saint Peter Parish in the near future.



MASS TIME CHANGES



es has been blessed to have Sr. Josephine Wagner, a daughter of the Cathedral Parish and a graduate of Allentown Central Catholic High School, assigned to teach 1st grade for the 2024-2025 school year. She joins Sr. Bernadette McCauley on the faculty (There are not too many schools that are blessed to have two sisters on the faculty). The six parishes that operate and support Good Shepherd School are responsible for providing the opportunity for the sisters to attend daily Mass before they begin the school day. Over the past few years this has been accomplished by providing the sisters with Mass at the convent on Mondays for their community. On the other days of the week, the assignment of a teacher's aide has made it possible for the sisters to attend the 8am Mass at one of the area parishes. This year, due to a change in the availability of a teacher's aide, another solution had to be found to provide a Mass for the sisters on Wednesday and Thursday. So as not to add another daily Mass to any of the parish schedules, Saint John the Baptist will have Mass at 7:00am on Thursday mornings and Assumption BVM will have 7:00am Mass on Wednesday mornings.

This change will become effective beginning on September 4 and 5.

I understand that this may not be convenient for those who attend daily Mass at St. John the Baptist. Holy Trinity Parish in Egypt and Saint John Fisher in North Catasauqua will continue to offer an 8:00am Mass on Wednesday and Thursday mornings. Anyone who has placed a Mass intention at Saint Peter or Saint John the Baptist on Thursdays and would like it moved to another day that is more convenient, may simply contact the rectories and we will happily transfer the intention to another day for you. Thank you for your continued cooperation.
