



An Academic Dean and lecturer at Institute of Catechesis and Pastoral Ministry, an affiliate Institute to the Catholic University of Eastern African in Nairobi – Kenya from 2008 to 2011. From December 2011 to December 2023 - I served as an Assistant General in the office of Education and Formation in the Missionary Congregation of the Evangelizing Sisters of Mary.
